Importance of Veteran Treatment Courts

Veterans Treatment Courts present an opportunity for us to come to the aid of the men and women in uniform who are suffering as a result of their sacrifice to this country and should be expanded to serve all veterans in need.

General Barry R. McCaffrey (Ret)

- Link between combat stress and involvement in the court system.
- Growing number of veterans appearing on dockets with substance abuse issues.
- Traditional social services not equipped to address combat stress.
- Need to engage VA, State Vets Depts., veterans orgs., and family support groups.

Importance of Veteran Treatment Courts

- Provides an alternative to incarceration
 - \$2 for every \$7 spent in regular court
 - \$200,000+ savings in jail costs alone for DUIs since Nov 2013
 - \$100,000+ in community restitution since Jan 2016 (VTC)
- Reduction in recidivism rate
 - Regular Court: 70% 80%
 - Treatment Court 25% 40%
 - Veteran Treatment Courts: 5% 25%
- Provides a platform for Justice Involved Veterans
 - Clean, Compliant & Connected



Lake Havasu City Veterans Treatment Court

- First Rural Veterans Treatment Court: Nov 8, 2013 with 1 Veteran
- 304 Veterans Court Participants Total
- 24 Active Duty identified (Municipal cases)
- 29 Veterans currently in program (2 pending Veterans)
- 9 Active Duty have participated in LHC Veterans Court
- Average length of program is 9 to 18 months
- 230 Veterans successfully completed the VTC program (Graduated)
- 8.7% recidivism rate for Veterans who graduated the program

- Specialty Courts are the most successful

 - Share resources and ideas
 - Excellent way to disseminate information
 - Raise money
