## Grants Made to Veterans in Housing-Related Financial Emergencies

- Luke Chapter MOAA: Arizona non-profit corporation, affiliate of national Military Officers Association of America
  - 165 retired/former uniformed officers & surviving spouses in West Valley area
  - Serving Arizona veterans since 1982
- Charitable outreach to needy veterans; 2017 to present
- Focus: financial emergencies related to homelessness / housing, including rent/mortgage, utilities, food needs, transportation
- AZ veterans: all services, all ranks, eligible w/honorable or general discharge
- Grants: range from \$500-\$2,500, paid 'to or for' veteran
  - No 'pass through' grants to other organizations; Luke Chapter deals direct w/veterans







### Chapter Volunteers Process Each Case

- Case handling w/ detailed policies, procedures and accounting
- Veteran submits grant application, DD214, record release, bills, etc.
- Referrals from BeConnected, VA social workers, County social agencies, VHV, etc.
- Lead case worker contacts Veteran, explains process, puts vet 'at ease'
- Panel of 3 officers interview veteran to learn military experience, current situation and needs; typically use Zoom
  - Many cases are urgent, eviction in process, mortgage foreclosure, utilities cut off, etc.
  - Grant decision is made immediately by the panel
- Our niche is speed; grant payment typically issued within 3-4 days
  - Checks paid via credit card and Zelle, or mailed directly to creditor; minimal delay







### Luke Chapter Helps Veterans and Families

- Funded by donations to Luke Chapter 501(c)(3) charity from members, and grants by MOAA Community Foundation and Az Dept Veterans' Services
  - Over 7 program years, Luke Chapter awarded grants to veterans TOTALING approx \$150,000
  - 1,000 packaged/canned food items and 60 gift cards/year at Luke AFB "Turkeys for Troops"
  - More than 120 individual veterans and families received cash grants
- Goal: Give the veteran a stepping-stone to recover financially




