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ARIZONAPURPLE STAR SCHOOLS

Purpose



Purple Star Schools is a program supporting military-connected children as they relocate to new schools due to a parent's change in duty station. Military children move every two to three years. The Purple Star School program is designed to help schools respond to the educational and social challenges military-connected children face during their transition to a new school and keep them on track to be college, workforce, and life-ready.



Annual Economic Impact

Components

- 1. Professional development training* to at least 70% of the school's employees, to the unique needs of military students.
- 2. Designates an employee to serve as the school's point of contact for the purple star school program.
- 3. Establishes a peer mentorship program for military students.
- 4. Holds at least one patriotic event during each school year.
- 5. Creates and maintains a website or a dedicated page on the school's website with resources.









